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The North Valley Community Foundation is accepting grant applications for North Complex Fire recovery projects that are focused on housing, health and well-being, and community development.

The NVCF North Complex Fire Grant Program is funded by the NVCF's Wildfire Relief and Recovery Fund, which is raising money to address a spate of fires in the region last summer.

Housing and survivor assistance were identified as top priorities facing our community in the wake of the North Complex Fire. The effect of sudden changes in population redistribution has a serious impact on the wildfire victims gaining access to resources in a quick and fair manner. Other program areas may be added as significant needs and opportunities emerge.

NVCF has assembled a grant selection committee of board members and community members to evaluate and approve all grants. Only nonprofit organizations and government agencies serving fire survivors can apply.

Read about the types of grants that will be considered, eligibility requirements and apply for grants at <https://www.nvcf.org/north-complex-fire-grant-program>. Two applications have been established -- one for \$5,000 or less and another for requests greater than \$5,000.

The grant program is particularly interested in projects and initiatives that serve the most vulnerable members of our community – those with the least resources and most needs, who have the most challenging time recovering. The program also seeks to fill gaps – providing shorter-term, catalytic funding that is not available elsewhere and has the potential to leverage longer-term ongoing support.
