Applications are now being accepted for nearly 20 college scholarships offered through North Valley Community Foundation.

Applications to the 18 scholarships managed by NVCF and details about each scholarship can be viewed at www.nvcf.org/scholarships. The deadline to apply for most scholarships is April 21.

The majority of the scholarships at NVCF are for graduating seniors who will be attending college in the fall, but there are some for current college students.

Last year, NVCF granted 38 scholarship awards totaling more than \$66,000 for students pursuing higher education.

Students from any high school in Butte, Glenn, Tehama or Colusa County can enter their school to see which scholarships they are eligible for.
